Dear Norwin High School Families,

This message is being sent to all Norwin High School students and families to share our specific plan for an important day of testing on Wednesday, October 13th. This is the date established to conduct <u>ASVAB</u> and <u>PSAT</u> testing as part of our college and career readiness program for students. Please see the specific grade-level plan below:

• Freshmen – Class of 2025

- Will <u>not</u> report to school as usual on Wednesday, October 13th but will participate in <u>remote asynchronous learning</u>. Students will participate in learning activities from home via work posted in Google Classroom with attendance based on completion of work.
- Select students will be informed to physically report to NHS by a casemanager/counselor to work on outstanding school work, complete assignments with their casemanager, or receive extra instructional assistance.

• Sophomores – Class of 2024

- o Will report to school for a full day and take the ASVAB or PSAT EXAM.
- o <u>ASVAB Exam:</u> Almost all students in 10th grade (NOA & NHS) will take the ASVAB Exam (expectation as part of our college and career readiness program)
- o PSAT Exam: Small group of select 10th graders already signed up through Guidance

• Juniors – Class of 2023

- Will report to school for a full day and take the ASVAB or PSAT EXAM.
- PSAT Exam: Almost all students in 11th grade (NOA & NHS) will take the PSAT Exam (as part of our college and career readiness program)
- ASVAB Exam: Small group of select 11th graders already signed up through Guidance

• Seniors – Class of 2022

- Will <u>not</u> report to school as usual on Wednesday, October 13th but will participate in remote asynchronous learning. Students will participate in learning activities from home via work posted in Google Classroom with attendance based on completion of work.
- Students who attend CWCTC may either report directly to CWCTC in the middle of the day or ride the school bus to NHS as usual in the morning. For students needing to ride the bus to NHS in the morning they will have a study hall here in the AM before lunch and we will transport to and from PM CWCTC as usual.
- Select students will be informed to physically report to NHS by a casemanager/counselor/principal to work on outstanding school work, complete assignments with their casemanager, or receive extra instructional assistance
